Is the frequency in use? (Let repeater drop)

Is there any Emergency or Priority traffic? (Let repeater drop)

Hearing nothing, this is *KJ4CZE* MY name is *Eddie*, and I am the *NEGARC SkyWarn Coordinator*. I am currently located in the Town of *Braselton, Georgia* and I will be your net control station for the *NEGARC SKYWARN Training net* this evening.

Will you please be the *Alternate Net Control Station*? Try for *AECs* next, or give up.

This net is held each Tuesday evening at 8:00 o'clock PM, 20 hundred hours local time. This net uses the *Northeast Georgia Amateur Radio Club, NE4GA* repeater in *Commerce Georgia*. its frequency is *147.225*. Please note that this repeater has a *Positive Offset* and uses a *PL tone* of *123.0*. If the *Northeast Georgia Amateur Radio Club* repeater is not available then the net will be called on the *Tri-County WX4TC* repeater which is *145.310* *Negative Offset* and a *PL Tone* of *123.0*

If neither repeater is available then the net will be called on our *Primary VHF Simplex* frequency of *145.000 MHz* simplex. Any fills?

When checking in, please slowly state your call sign phonetically, regularly, state your name, your current location, and if you have any announcements for the net this evening. We will begin check-ins tonight starting first with *SKYWARN Spotters*.

Any *SKYWARN* member wishing to check in - please call *KJ4CZE*, net control, now. (Take check-ins)

We will now take general check ins, again - please slowly state your callsign phonetically, regularly, state your name, your current location, and if you have any announcements for the net this evening.

Anyone, anywhere wishing to check in please call *KJ4CZE*, net control, now. (Take check-ins)

Are there any questions or comments before we close the net this evening? (If you would like you may insert a training topic here or handle questions)

I would like to thank everyone for checking in tonight. I would also like to thank the *Northeast Georgia Amateur Radio Club* for allowing us the use of the repeater.
